THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

20th August 2017

There are two important themes in today's scripture readings.

- In the reading from Isaiah, we are encouraged to welcome all-comers to worship God – Christians, Jews, Moslems, and those of other faiths and of none: all are welcome, and our role is to practise our faith actively, with enthusiasm and commitment, and to give an example which others will follow.
- In Mathews Gospel reading, the Canaanite woman gives us an excellent example of how persistence in our faith will help us to overcome difficulties of all sorts, and how the power of prayer allows God's goodness to be always in our thoughts, words and deeds. The Samaritan woman was firstly a woman of love; when the life of her child is threatened, a mother's love knows no limits. She was a woman of faith; she seemed to have complete confidence that Jesus could help her daughter. She was a woman of tireless persistence; little could discourage her. She met a wall of silence, but she kept asking. She met a rebuff, but just threw herself at the feet of Jesus. She was insulted, but turned the insult round with a flash of humour and finally her wish was granted. It is that kind of persistent faith which keeps faith alive in our daily struggles of life.
