THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

As we celebrated Easter, we were reminded of the enormity of the events of 2000 years ago. Maybe we stopped for a little time in our hectic lives to try to imagine what reaction there would have been had the same events happened in today's world...Thankfully, the story continues, albeit in different ways:

It is heartening to see how Christianity breaks through the distractions of present-day living at Easter and touches so many people's lives. We can recognise a few close-to-home examples which contribute to the continuing worldwide growth and influence of Christianity:

- Mass attendance doubles, trebles or quadruples throughout the country, (and worldwide) bringing many people back to God, who, for a variety of reasons, have not worshipped frequently for most of the year.
- Thousands of 'Churches Together' Groups around the country (including Epping) hold a Walk of Witness on Good Friday, which reminds those who see their local Walk that something important is happening.
- The two Good Friday performances of 'The Passion of Christ' by the Wintershall Players (with animals) in Trafalgar Square were seen by 20,000 people this year!
- Young people of 'The Student Cross' walk hundreds of miles during Holy Week, from various parts of England (including Epping). All 11 groups carry a heavy wooden Cross and meet on Good Friday at The National Shrine at Walsingham in Norfolk to celebrate Easter together with other pilgrims. They will have been seen by many thousands of people on their way to Walsingham, as they proclaim the Easter message.

Christianity is alive and active!! We all have our part to play every day!!
