## THE BIRTH OF SAINT JOHN THE BAPTIST (B) 24<sup>th</sup> June 2018

## Dear Friends.

The angel said, "Zachariah, your prayer has been heard. Your wife Elizabeth is to bear you a son and you must name him John" (Luke 1:15-80). There are many points to reflect on in celebrating the birth of St John the Baptist. He is the only saint whose birth the Church celebrates as a feast and with a distinct vigil Mass. Zachariah and Elizabeth, an elderly couple, did not have a child which was a grief to them, but they prayed that God would give them a child. There are many couples today who have problems with fertility and who wish that they could conceive a child, but it does not happen for them. They and we need to pray for couples in that situation, that God's creative love may be at work in their life.

John the Baptist was filled with the Holy Spirit when the Blessed Mother, Mary, visited her cousin Elizabeth, to be with her in her confinement. John in womb of Elizabeth leaps for joy at the coming of Jesus, the Saviour, in the womb of Mary. Mothers carrying a child in their womb are also blessed by God, for his creative power is a work in their life and they are privileged to be life givers with him.

God has a plan for John the Baptist, that he will be a prophet like Elijah, who will "prepare a way for the Lord, and turn the hearts of fathers towards their children, and turn the disobedient back to the wisdom that the virtuous have". God also has a plan for each one of us to co-operate with him in the mission, responsibilities and opportunities he gives us. Stephen Grellet's quote says, "I shall pass through this world but once. Any good that I can do or any kindness that I can show, let me do it now. Let me not defer or neglect it, for I shall not pass this way again".

John grew up, his spirit matured to his principal ministry of baptising Jesus in the Jordan. We too are called to mature in spirit and in relationship with God and people. Each of us, in our own way, can bring God the Father, Jesus his Son, and his Spirit to people, and we can bring people to God. There is sacredness about the life of every person for we are all created by gift of God. We are destined at the end of our life, with the help of his grace, to be taken up into his perfect love.

May the Lord bless and guide you with his Word made flesh. Fr John

TALKS ON OUR CATHOLIC FAITH: In September we will start a series of talks on the Catholic faith for adults interested in finding out about our faith, becoming Catholic or who wish to understand our faith or support family members in their faith. We will celebrate the 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Consecration of our Church on December 7<sup>th</sup>, the eve of the feast of the Immaculate Conception and Patron of our Church, and will complete the apostolic number by putting up eight more candles and crosses. The cost of each cross is £20 and of a candle holder (similar to the existing ones) is £180. If you would like to donate a brass cross or candle holder, please use a red donation envelope in the Church and give them to Fr John or hand them into the Priest's House. The offerings for this purpose can also be Gift Aided by people who are paying tax.
