THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

What a wonderful result for English football on Monday evening!!

The 24 million viewers who are reported to have watched the England game versus Columbia were in a state of ecstasy after the final penalty kick. The members of the team led the way with unrestrained joy, and the TV reports on Tuesday from several dozen venues around the country reflected similar jubilation. Here was a feast of joy to beat all joyful emotions.....or was it?

Sometimes we forget that such joy can be experienced each time we receive Holy Communion at Mass. Some good Catholics experience this emotion every weekend, but some lose their sense of priorities when they put entertainment or shopping, for example, ahead of their worship of God with the Catholic community. They cannot experience their moment of spiritual ecstasy.

Enjoyment of all normal entertainment or other pleasurable activities is to be encouraged, but should never be allowed to come ahead of our weekly meeting with God at Mass. Regular weekly church-goers will see each week the miracle of the transubstantiation of bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ and can glory in this great gift from Jesus, Similarly, we can become ecstatic about the promise of being able to spend eternity with God in heaven when our 'final whistle' is blown and we shall be called to account for the way in which we have lived our lives.

Coming to Mass each week is a 'win-win' situation for us.
