THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

Do we sometimes find it a bit inconvenient being a Christian? Can we possibly be worthy to be a true disciple of God? Because of our human weakness, on occasions, we do things which displease God, (for example, finding it inconvenient to do what God wants us to do); nevertheless we have been empowered, through our Baptism and Confirmation, to be messengers of God's will to others, as we demonstrate our Christian values by what we say and do. Surely, our proactive Christian commitment has to be our first priority in life and we should fit in other priorities around it, if and when we can.

Frequently, we are challenged by God through our conscience, (in today's world, this is rather like receiving a message from God on our mobile phone!), and we should listen to these challenges and respond to them positively and with Christian commitment as we say to God: 'Here I am Lord, let me know what it is that you want me to do for you'. Having heard and understood God's message, when we do what he has asked us to do the results will often amaze us, and others and will help to strengthen our own faith in God's love and make us always ready to respond to God's messages with enthusiasm.

In today's Gospel, Peter responds slowly to a seemingly unlikely request of Jesus. He was reluctant to do what Jesus had asked, as he was overcome by the enormity of the power of Jesus. Jesus then assured Peter that he and his friends should not be frightened by his power, but instead suggested that he should turn his attention away from being a normal fisherman to becoming a 'fisher of men'.....and that is what we all are as we help others to come to know and follow Jesus in their lives!! When we do this, we are simply acting as Jesus' mouthpiece. It is his message that we pass on.
