#### SEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME C 24 FEBRUARY 2019

My dear Friends,

"What you measure out is what you will be given back" (Luke 6: 27-38). In these words Jesus sums up the reward we can expect to receive, or lose, due to the way we measure our love or treat others. Today's Gospel develops Christ's teaching for Christian living in The Beatitudes. *Compassionate* is a key word in today's readings. It means to share with another in their suffering or to put one's self in their place. In response to Psalm 102 we say "The Lord is compassion and love". Jesus was compassionate and stood in our place as he shared in our sufferings. He sacrificed his will and life in faithfulness to his heavenly Father and out of love for us. He wanted to show us how to be freed from a self-centred way of thinking and acting and to be focused on God and others rather than our self. He showed us that love is sacrifice, and that it was his sacrificial love that led him to suffering death on the cross and the glory of resurrection. The fruit of his love is that we are now enabled to share in the life of grace, and glory of the kingdom of God.

We welcome Bishop Alan on a Pastoral Visit to our parish this Sunday. The bishop is the chief shepherd of the flock in the diocese, and through Bishop Alan we are united with the Bishop of Rome, Pope Francis. Through that linkage our unity and communion with one another, and Catholics throughout the world, is expressed and sustained. On Friday last we celebrated the feast of the Chair of St Peter, and Pope Francis sits on that chair above the tomb of St Peter, in St Peter's Basilica in Rome. Jesus in response to Peter's profession of faith in him as "The Saviour of World" was to tell him to "Confirm the faith of his brethren".

Today Bishop Alan will celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation and Confirm eleven young people in our parish at 11am Mass. We congratulate them and their parents as their faith was initiated at their Baptism, nurtured in the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Holy Communion, and is confirmed or strengthened today in the Sacrament of Confirmation when they will receive the gifts of the Holy Spirit. The gifts of the Holy Spirit are: wisdom and understanding, counsel and fortitude, knowledge and holiness, and fear (reverence) of the Lord. These gifts are necessary for all of us, when we need to call on the Lord to help and guide us. Using these gifts with faith, we can be truly compassionate and loving in a way that will lead us to put God's plan and the needs of others before our self.

May the Lord bless and guide us with the gifts of his Spirit Fr John
