THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

Christmas provides an emotional buzz for the population at large, as we are bombarded, from summer onwards, with insistent suggestions regarding what should be our Yuletide priorities, and how we should spend our money and our time amidst the bling and often frantic razzmatazz of the Christmas season . For we Christians, our main focus should be on celebrating the anniversary of the coming arrival of the Christ-child, with other 'priorities' being of secondary importance.

However, Easter, and not Christmas, is the highpoint of the Christian year, with Lent and Passiontide preceding it, during which we have the opportunity to review our way of life and our priorities and to make any adjustments which will be pleasing to God. As the clock ticks on towards the remarkable miracle of the Resurrection of Jesus, we are encouraged to spend some of our time during Lent in prayer, when we can have a conversation with God about our love for him and our shortcomings in the way in which we live our life..

It is a wonderful gift to us, to know that we will be forgiven all our indiscretions when we express our sorrow to God for the times we have failed to live up to the high Christian standards. If we are truly sorry for them, minor sins are forgiven during such conversations with God, and such conversations should be a daily feature in our life. Should we need to seek forgiveness for more serious indiscretions, we need to discuss these with a priest in the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

To receive God's forgiveness during Lent (or indeed at any time), is a cause for great joy for us, particularly as it precedes the ultimate joy of Eastertide.
