THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

The incredible events described in the Gospel for this weekend, unusually appear in our Readings every year in the 3-year cycle of Readings, so emphasising the importance of the Transfiguration of Jesus to us all. The Transfiguration reveals the Divinity of Christ to Peter, James and John at the top of a mountain where they had gone to pray with Jesus. As Jesus prayed, the aspect of his face was changed and his clothing became brilliant with light. The link of Christianity with the history of Old Testament times was emphasised by the presence of Moses and Elijah, who both also appeared in glory. As Peter, James and John tried to recover from their surprise at these events, the voice of God announced from a cloud that 'this is my Son, the Chosen One, Listen to him'.

Thus it was established that Jesus was the Messiah, being divine and at the same time, human and that he had the full blessing of God in all that he was to do. What a dramatic and astounding event, reflection upon which surely encourages us as we continue our Lenten faith journey.

This Sunday is 17th March, when we celebrate the Feast of St Patrick, the Patron Saint of Ireland. We wish all those with Irish connections a happy Feast Day. It is a particularly poignant date in my personal life, as I was received into the Catholic Church on 17th March 62 years ago. Happy St Patrick's Day!!
