THIRD SUNDAY IN LENT C

24th MARCH 2019

My dear Friends,

God called from the middle of the burning bush and said, "Moses, Moses, come no nearer. Take your shoes off for the place on which you stand is holy ground" (Exodus 3:1-15). In this age we are increasingly aware of the importance of protecting the environment for future generations, yet there is a diminishing sense of the sacred in the world. The material and secular blinds people to the spiritual so that we do not see the presence of God in a person or in creation. The sacred and spiritual, which sustain life and nature, are often not recognised and disregarded as worthless or irrelevant. Could it be that we, like Moses, are walking on holy ground and sacred space, but do not recognise the presence of God in our time and place?

When we go into a Church we genuflect with our right knee touching the floor at our left heel, to show that we are honouring Christ who is in that sacred place. On entering a Mosque, people take off their shoes, as Moses did, to show one walks on holy ground in the presence of God and that we must worship him. Whilst God is present everywhere, we must always honour him in people and holy places. We need to be aware that his presence is real to us in the Church; a building consecrated to God where his people gather for worship and prayer. That is why we bow or genuflect and are silent before him.

God is present when his Word in Sacred Scripture, is read aloud to us, and he is truly present in Holy Communion. He is present "where two or three are gathered together in his name". The many and varied presences of God is a comfort and strength to us in the various situations we go through, for the Lord does not leave us to cope or journey alone in life, but is with us at all times. St Patrick, whose feast is celebrated in March, expresses this beautifully in his prayer: "Christ, be beside me, Christ be before me, Christ be behind me, King of my heart ...". We would do well to make this lovely prayer or hymn a consistent part of our own prayer, as we reflect on God's ongoing presence and constant love for us. Jesus too assures us of his ongoing presence and love when he says, "Behold I am with you always, to ;the end of time" (Matthew 28:20).

May the Lord reveal his presence to you and your family. Fr John

CYCLONE IDAI EMERGENCY APPEAL: CAFOD has joined forces with DEC, Disasters Emergency Committee to reach hundreds of thousands of people affected by Cyclone Idai, across Southern Africa. In a statement, Bishop Charles Kasonde of Solwezi, Chairman of the Association of Episcopal Conferences in Eastern Africa, called for people to "respond to the cry for humanitarian assistance in whichever way possible". This need is urgent as everyone is in need of food, clean water and shelter, with some shelters already at capacity. £30 can provide blankets to keep two families warm, £50 could provide a family with food for a month and £100 could help build a toilet and washing facilities for families who lost their homes. After all Masses next weekend we will hold a retiring collection to support the Appeal. Please be generous!
