# PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD C 14.4.2019 My dear Friends,

"His state was divine, yet Christ Jesus did not cling to his equality with God but emptied himself to assume the condition of a slave, and became as all men are" (Philippians 2:6-11). Here St Paul tells us of the divine and human nature of Jesus who gave up his glory and was humbler by going through suffering and death on the Cross. On Palm Sunday the Church takes us into the popularity passing glory of Jesus. In Holy Week, we enter his sufferings and being glorified through death on the Cross, on Good Friday. Christ, the innocent Lamb of God, was put to death, and through his sufferings, death and resurrection God gives the hope and the promise of eternal life to all who have faith in Christ, our Saviour.

On Wednesday at 7pm in Brentwood Cathedral, Bishop Alan will celebrate the Chrism Mass with the priests of our Diocese. During the Mass, priests will renew their commitment of ordination. The Holy Oils will also be blessed at the Mass. The Oil of Baptism to prepare people for Baptism and reception into the Church. The Oil of Chrism to anoint people at Baptism and seal them with the gift of the Holy Spirit in Confirmation, and ordain men for the service of God and people in Holy Orders and the priesthood. It is also used to consecrate Altars and Churches for the service of God and people.

On Maundy (Holy) Thursday at 7.30pm we celebrate the Mass of Our Lord's Supper, when Jesus instituted the Holy Eucharist and changed bread and wine into his Body and Blood, and told us: "Do this in memory of me". The washing of feet shows his humble service, giving us a New Commandment to love one another. The Mass ends with a procession to the Altar of Repose. There will be prayer in Church until 10pm to share with Jesus, in Agony in the Garden.

On Good Friday we have the remembrance of Jesus sufferings and death on the Cross, and his laying down his life in sacrifice to take away the sins of the world

At the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday and Easter Sunday, we rejoice in Christ's victory over sin, suffering and death, in his glorious resurrection. We Christians, whether at home or away, should make a special effort to take part in the Holy Week and Easter Services. This is the most important week in the year when we celebrate God's love for us, and the new life of grace he gives us through Christ.

May Christ's suffering and death touch our hearts and minds. Fr John
