SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER C Divine Mercy Sunday 28 April 2019 My dear Friends,

Jesus said: "Receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. For those whose sins you forgive, they are forgiven; for those whose sins you retain they are retained" (John 20:19-31). Many people today do not believe there is such a thing as sin, yet we need to recognise and repent of our sins so that God can forgive us. Christ came into the world to save people from sin and bring us into right relationship with God. He calls us to turn away from sin and sinful ways of thinking, acting and living, and believe in the Good News of God's mercy and forgiveness for all who repent. Pope John Paul II designated this Sunday as Divine Mercy day, as it shows Jesus giving the apostles and their successors power to forgive or retain peoples sins. It is great consolation to have one's sins forgiven, but it is a spiritually blindness not to recognise our sins and our need for forgiveness. Jesus speaks in The Beatitudes of blessings, for those who know their need of God's mercy and forgiveness when he said; "Blessed are the poor in spirit for theirs is the kingdom of heaven" (Matt.5:1).

In Catholic tradition, it is obligatory for us to confess and receive forgiveness of our sins in the Sacrament of Penance, and receive Holy Communion between Ash Wednesday and Trinity Sunday. This reflects the process of reconciliation presented by Jesus in the Parable of the Prodigal Son (Luke 15:11-32). The son, who returned to his father, humbly confessed he had offended against God and people. He expressed his sorrow and unworthiness and his father embraced him in love and forgiveness. The father celebrated and sealed his return to family life and right relationship with a party. That is a model for us to confess and repent of our sins, to receive forgiveness from God, and then enter into a Holy Communion with Christ our Lord in the Holy Eucharist – which he also gave us for the forgiveness of sins.

Pope John Paul told us that Jesus appeals for and gives the mercy of God to people, in his crucifixion and resurrection. He makes reparation for people's sins, springing from the supreme love of the Father for all people. The divine dimension of redemption is put into effect not only by bringing justice to bear upon sin, but by restoring to love that creative power in mankind, so that once more we have access to the fullness of life and holiness, which comes to us as a gift from God (Dives Misericordia – Rich in Mercy).

I thank you for your greetings and very generous Easter offerings. I wish you and vour families continued blessings and joy in this lovely Easter season. Fr John
