FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT YEAR A 1st December 2019

Dear Friends,

Jesus said, Stand ready because the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect" (Matt.24:37-44). The word Advent means coming and in this season the Church prepares us to celebrate the first coming of Jesus into our world at Bethlehem and calls us to prepare for his second coming. In Christian and Jewish tradition, it is necessary to engage in purification and repentance from sin, so as to be prepared to meet with God, and this is only possible with the help of his grace.

Jesus spoke about his second coming at the Parousia, at the end of time. That will be unexpected when it will happen and for which most people will not be prepared. He calls us to be vigilant and have a sense of expectancy so that we will be ready to receive him when he comes.

St Paul tells us that the way to prepare for the Lord is by being awake and attentive to him and to live as people of holiness in the light and, not in the darkness or in sin (Romans 13:11-14). There was much depravity and sin in first century Rome, and the issues St Paul was addressing in his own time still destroy people's lives today. He called on people not to engage in drunkenness, promiscuity or immorality. Yet the culture of our time suggests these things are all right, when in fact they offend against decency and harm our better nature. St Paul tells us the Lord is very near to us as a judge, who will separate good from evil, and falsehood from truth. So, let us live as children of the light, not engaging in sinful or immoral actions, but living spiritual lives that prepare us to be holy and ready to encounter Christ.

When Christ, the Saviour, finally redeems the world and its people, all creation will be transformed. Isaiah (2:1-5) prophesied there will be a renewed creation and a new world order. Redeemed people will be in right relationship with God, and there will be a harmony in nature, as creation restored to the Creator's original design.

We thank everyone who worked so hard and local businesses who contributed in many ways to the success of our Christmas Market & Bazaar on this Saturday. Thank you to everyone and to who gave donations as Patrons and all who obtained gifts, vouchers and prizes from the local businesses. Thank you to everyone who contributed, and to Margaret Lechley who edited and prepared our **Parish Cookbook titled "Our Cherished recipes"** which is on now on sale. It has many very thoughtful and tasty recipes. *I wish you a blessed Advent. Fr John*
