THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

The Church's season of Advent starts in sobering vein. In the first two weeks we are called to prepare ourselves for our personal meeting with God when we die and to become more aware of the approaching end of the world as we know it — as described by Jesus. At the same time, and almost as a secondary consideration, we also think about the coming birthday of Jesus at Christmas.

The Church then gives us a welcome break as we celebrate the third week of Advent, starting today from *Gaudete Sunday*, when we are encouraged to Rejoice (Gaudete) at the coming birthday of Jesus. It is fair to say that preparations for Christmas in many of the shops and households up and down the country are under way by September and our minds are bombarded by offers of one kind or another for the three months leading up to Christmas.

But let us remember that preparations for our Christmas season festivities should be seen as merely a brief distraction from our main lifetime focus as Christians, namely: pleasing God in all that we say and do. As we look around us, we can surely appreciate the many reasons for us to Rejoice on this Gaudete Sunday:

- The gift of life and of God's love for each one of us.
- The joy of our faith and the joy of sharing it with others.
- The goodness of family and friends.
- The opportunities to help those in need.
- A fair, beautiful, and generally peaceful country in which to live.

Often, we overlook these and other sustaining features as we live out our daily life, but today, on this Rejoice Sunday, it is good to spend some time just thinking about the many good things which abound in our lives, in our community and in our country, and to thank God for all of them.
