### THIRD SUNDAY IN LENT - YEAR A

15<sup>th</sup> March 2020

### Dear friends,

Jesus said, "Anyone who drinks the water that I shall give will never be thirsty again and the water that I shall give will turn into a spring inside him welling up to eternal life", (Jn.4:5-42). In this Gospel Jesus meets a Samaritan woman at Jacob's well and teaches about the "water of life", that he offers to all who believe in him. There is a picture by Sieger Koder called "insight" showing the woman looking down into the well and seeing a reflection of the face of Christ as well as her own face in the water. It is a profound message that if we look deep enough, we can see the face of Christ in ourselves and in other people.

It is wicked to treat anyone in an inhumane way for there is the face and presence of Christ and something of the divine nature of God in every person. If we understood this, we would have tremendous reverence for our own and other people's bodies, as temples and dwelling places of the Spirit of God. Priests and people reverence the body of a dead person at a funeral by blessing it with holy water and incense. At that time, we honour the life of God, that a person enters into through the waters of Baptism, and which they will come to share fully at the resurrection of the dead.

The grace of God and fountain of life is given to Christians by water and the Holy Spirit in Baptism. We are washed clean of sin and given the new life of grace in this holy and life-giving water. The Spirit of God living in our heart gives us a share in the life and divine nature of God. He makes us holy and sacred, and sustains and renews our relationship with God in the Christian community. The woman who came to the well found Jesus, and he opened her heart to the new life of faith and relationship with God. Christ, who is the truth, gave her the truth and a new dignity that we share as children of God. When we sprinkle and bless ourselves with holy water we are renewed in grace by Christ, the spring of living water who lives in our heart. It is only by his grace that we are able to grow in love of God and people, and enabled to love and reverence ourselves properly as God wills.

In Lent try to draw close to God and come to Mass on weekdays as well as Sunday. We have evening Mass with Stations of the Cross on Fridays for people going to work and there are morning Masses or Midday on Wednesdays. We have prayer and adoration before the Blessed Sacrament on Mondays and Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays. One can visit the church any day to pray the Stations of the Cross or for quiet personal prayer. May the Lord bless us during this Lent. Fr John
