## Dear friends and Parishioners,

"Filled with the Holy Spirit, Jesus left the Jordan and was led by the Spirit through the wilderness, being tempted there by the devil for forty days" (Luke 4:1-13). Following his Baptism by John the Baptist, the Spirit comes down on Jesus and he was affirmed by God the Father that This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased"(Lk.3:22). Whilst that was a joyful and affirmative experience for Christ, it was immediately followed by the Spirit leading him out into the wilderness to be tested and tempted when he was weak from the hunger. There were three principal temptations presented to Jesus, all of which centred on himself and exercising a power which he had to perform miracles. He rejects all the temptations and tells us "Learn from me for I am gentle and humble of heart", for all his miracles were for the glory of God his Father and the service of people – not the promotion of or exaltation of himself.

Each of us too has been given the Spirit of God, who dwells in our hearts and we are called and prompted to be led by that Spirit. Whilst he gives us love, joy and peace as his fruits in our lives (Galatians 5:16-26), he also allows us to be tested and tempted, with recurring temptations in the course our life". Lent is a time for us to journey with Jesus in the wilderness of our life, when we are confronted with personal weaknesses, temptations and sins. We call on Jesus, our Saviour to give us grace and strength to reject temptations to centre on self by giving alms for the good of others, praying and making sacrifices for the glory of God.

We will welcome Bishop Alan, our Bishop on a Pastoral Visit to our parish on Wednesday, 23<sup>rd</sup> March, when he will celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation for young parishioners at the evening Mass. We pray for all who have been preparing for Confirmation and the Sacraments in our Parish.
