SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT YEAR C

13th March 2022

Dear friends and Parishioners,

A voice came from the cloud saying, 'This is my Son, the Chosen One. Listen to him' (Luke 9:28-36). Jesus took Peter, James and John to the mountain to pray. When he was in prayer to God his Father, his face was changed and he was transfigured before them. Moses the lawgiver, and Elijah the prophet who was to return again, appeared to him and spoke with him. His Transfiguration in glory on that mountain was to strengthen him to climb the other mountain of Calvary, on which he would be glorified on the Cross. There, in sacrificing his life on the Cross, he would give himself up in love for sinful men and women and be glorified. Jesus experience and vision of God's glory, with the two great personalities of the Old Testament was also to strengthen his apostles and show them that he was the fulfilment of the Law and the Prophets and was to help them prepare for his suffering and death, about which he spoke to them.

Lent is the season in which we prepare for Holy Week and Easter, by sharing with Christ in his temptations and fasting in the desert, and to be ready to enter into his sufferings and death on the Cross. By going into the desert with him we are purified and graced for our mission in life – a unique mission that God gives to each one of us. By going up to his Father in prayer we are changed and the circumstances in which we live and labour are changed. By listening to and being led by his Word as "The Beloved Son" we are strengthened in facing the difficulties and sufferings of life. It is by going through these steps, we come to share in the glory of his resurrection and new life at Easter. What we intended to do for Lent and what we may be doing now could be quite different. If we have slipped up already in our Lent resolutions, we should not give up. Let us start again and not let our failures, big or small, decide how we go on.

We will welcome Bishop Alan, our Bishop on a Pastoral Visit to our parish on Wednesday, 23^{rd} March, when he will celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation for young parishioners at evening Mass. We pray for all who have been preparing for Confirmation and the Sacraments in our Parish at this time. May the Lord strengthen them, and all of us, with his Spirit and lead us in our faith journey with a stronger a faith, greater hope and deeper love.

May Christ bless and strengthen you in your Lent journey with him. Fr John
