SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY 12th June 2022

Dear Friends and Parishioners.

Jesus said "I have many things to say to you, but they would be too much for you now, but when the Spirit of truth comes, he will lead you into the complete truth" (John 16:12-15). Today we celebrate the feast of the Most Holy Trinity, and worship God our Father and Creator; Jesus, Son of God, our Saviour and brother; and the Holy Spirit, the creative power and presence of God in the world who makes us holy. Jesus recognised that there was only so much his apostles could understand or take in during his short time with them, so he told them that he would ask his Father to send the Holy Spirit upon them to deepen their understanding of the truths he had revealed to them.
