## Dear Friends and Parishioners,

Jesus called his disciples to "Follow me" (Lk.9:51-62) and Elijah called Eisha, his disciple, to follow him (1Kings 19:16-21). In these readings Elijah and Jesus were preparing to leave this world but arranged for God's word and work, to be continued through other people. Their successors, the prophets and apostles, were chosen, not just by people, but by God's Spirit who would anoint them with power, so that they could speak God's Word to people in a prophetic way to save them. Elisha, had to keep his focus on Elijah, his master, "so that he would be able to inherit a double share of his spirit". The apostles had to keep their focus on Jesus in order to be able to carry out, with faith, the mission he entrusted to them. Peter was even able to walk across water, with faith, when he kept his focus on Jesus, but as soon as he took his eyes off the Lord, he began to flounder and sink.

The disciples were amazed at the wonderful things God did in and through them, when they did what Jesus told them. When we follow the call of Jesus' by obeying him, looking to him and listening to him, great things can happen that transform our lives and the lives of others. Whether we are young, middle aged or elderly; poor or rich, healthy or sick; weak or strong, educated or illiterate, married or single, widowed or divorced, the Lord calls us to, "Follow me". It matters not who we are, what we do or what our condition of life is; God loves each one of us and Jesus calls us to "Follow me" in that time and place. When addressing the problems and burdens of life, He says to us, "If anyone wants to be a follower of mine, let him renounce himself and take up his cross daily and follow me".

Our thanks to everyone in our parish who has given so generously of their time and talents in the service of others in our community over the past year, i.e. since last September. In a way parish life follows the school or academic year as things tend to start in September and then end in July. We particularly thank Martin Griffin and the team of Catechists who prepared a two years group of children for first Holy Communion this year. We now need to start planning again for the start in September for next group of first Holy Communion children and would like to hear from parishioners who are willing to be Catechists. I would be most grateful to hear from suitable parishioners who may be willing to help with this key task of faith formation. It will also give the time to make the preparations necessary, to undertake this most important role of forming children in their Catholic faith.
