TWENTY-NINTH SUNDAY - ORDINARY TIME C 16 October 2022

Dear Friends & Parishioners,

"From where shall come my help? My help shall come from the Lord who made heaven and earth" (Psalm 120). This Psalm promises us God's and is used on for blessing: – the blessing of people on taking up a vocation in life or in Church, the blessing of homes or a Church and those going on a journey. Many do not see a need to ask God for his blessing and protection in their situations. When we recognise our vulnerability or frailty, we see the need to ask God to protect and bless us and our loved ones at the beginning, the end and during the day. We say in the Church's Night Prayer: "Protect us, Lord, while we are awake and safeguard us while we sleep that we may keep watch with Christ and rest with him in peace."

Moses with the support of others offered constant prayer for the people who were under attack (Exodus 17:8-13). God answered his prayer and gave protection and victory to his people in time of danger. We see the need for people to pray together, in the Old Testament, to support each other in prayer and lift one another up to God. It also shows that people are left vulnerable and weaker when there is no prayer or grace to support them at perilous times. Moses prayed for the people in danger - Jesus too prayed for his friends that their faith might not fail them and that they might be faithful and persevere in the face of threat and danger.

Jesus, tells us to persevere in prayer, especially when we might feel God is not listening to us or responding to our prayer (Luke 18:1-8). Jesus shows a woman pestering an unjust judge for justice, to show how important it is that we persevere in our prayer, trusting that God will respond to our pleas. It is not easy, when we pray for something vital, for a family member or our self, and God does not seem to answer our prayer. Yet, prayer transforms lives and situations, for it lifts people and ourselves up to God and by uplifting the problems of earth to heaven, God's grace comes down from heaven to help people and ourselves here on earth.

The last verse of the Gospel asks a key question about our relationship with God: "When the Son of Man comes will he find any faith on earth?" It may be easy to have or sustain faith in God when all goes well and he seems to be answering our prayer, as we want, but when faith is tested in difficult situations or apparently hopeless circumstances: then, most of all, we need to turn to God with faith and hope, so that he will strengthen and save us.

May the Lord come our aid and save us through faith. Fr John
