SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT YEAR A 4th December 2022

Dear Friends and Parishioners,

Jesus said, "The Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect" (Matt.24:37-44). The word Advent means coming and in this short season the Church calls us to prepare to celebrate the first coming of Jesus into the world at his birth and prepare for his second coming, which will be at the end of time. For his first coming the Gospel tells us "that a sense of expectancy had arisen amongst the people" but for his second coming at the Parousia, Jesus tells us the time and date is known only to his Father in heaven, and not revealed to anyone on earth.

Advent is a season when the Church calls us to purify our mind and heart, so that we will welcome Christ as his holy people or person. We do this by recognising our failings and sins, confessing them to the Lord. Then we seek forgiveness and reconciliation with him and others, especially in the Sacrament of Reconciliation, which seals God' forgiveness for us. During the past week children preparing for First Holy Communion in our parish celebrated the Sacrament of Reconciliation for the first time. It has been a joyful celebration for the children and their families, as they received God's love forgiveness in this Sacrament of healing and reconciling

Jesus tells to "Stay awake" with a sense of vigilance to prepare for his coming for his coming, which could happen at any moment, when he will come in glory on the clouds of heaven. In the Lord's Prayer, we pray daily in the words of Jesus, "Thy Kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven". The time of the Lord's coming on the clouds of heaven will show us that God's Kingdom has come and that the world as we know will pass away and that there will be a new creation and there will be a new heaven and earth, when all things will be made new.

His coming will be preceded by fears, wars and conflicts and disturbances in nature and creation. But Jesus will come as Saviour at the end of time to free people from fear and offer them liberation and salvation. St Paul urges us: "Make more and more progress in the kind of life you are meant to live: the life that God wants, as you have learnt it". He asks us to increase in love, be confirmed in holiness and be blameless in the sight of God (1Thess.3). During Advent, to prepare for Christmas and celebrate the birth of Christ our Saviour with reverence, let us listen to the Word of the Lord and the call of St John the Baptist made to people all those years ago and which we need to heed today: "Prepare ye the Way of the Lord".

May the Lord bless us during Advent and help us prepare his Way. Fr John
