FOURTH SUNDAY OF LENT A

19th March 2023

Dear Friends & Parishioners.

Jesus said to the blind man, "Go and wash in the pool of Siloam, a name that means sent" (John 9:1-18). There were stages of healing for the man who was born blind that might have challenged his faith and that of people around him. Jesus sees the blind man, recognises his need for healing, spat on the ground and makes a paste with his spittle and then tells the man to go and wash. He then gets the gift sight, having acted with faith and obedience to Jesus command.

Blindness is not just a physical condition affecting our body, for we can also have a mental or spiritual blindness. Blindness of the mind afflicts those unable to understand or empathise with others and can only see things from their own viewpoint. It is a real gift and grace to be able to see understand and see where others are coming from and sympathise with them and meet them halfway.

Spiritual blindness afflicts people like the Pharisees who did not have faith in Jesus as Saviour. They limit God with a restricted or narrow mind-set and do not have faith to see God work out his purpose and mission to save us through Jesus Christ. It is the man who was physically blind who has eyes of faith to see and profess his belief in Jesus. There are many who do not have faith in God or in Jesus his Son as the Saviour of the world. Faith is a grace from God enabling us to see his presence in the world, in people and in our own life. Only with faith can we say truly that Jesus is Lord, Son of God and Saviour of the world.

We may say "I can't see where he or she is coming from" and so be blind and incapable of seeing another's position. Faith is a gift from God that we dare not take for granted, since people can and do lose faith. Faith enables us to relate to God in prayer and to see his presence in times of need or tragedy, as well as in the normal or beautiful. We grow in faith by reading or listening to God's Word in the Bible, by communing with him in private prayer and public worship. We ask Jesus to strengthen our faith, so that with eyes of faith we may see his presence in our life, in others, in the church and the world

We pray for, honour thank and God our mothers, on this Mothering Sunday. We ask God to bless them as we give thanks for the gift of motherhood – a gift and calling which they share with Mary, Mother of Jesus and Mother of the Church. *May the Lord bless us with the vision of his presence in our world. Fr John*
