FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER A

Dear Friends & Parishioners,

Jesus said, "I am the gate of the sheepfold. Anyone who enters through me will be safe" (John 10:1-10). We all want to be in a safe place where we can feel secure, and that is not just about location but also about a state of mind and wellbeing. This Fourth Sunday of Easter is called "Good Shepherd Sunday" as Jesus, the risen Lord and Saviour, speaks of himself as the Good Shepherd who looks after his sheep and lays down his life for them. His laying down of his life out of love for people, and in submission to his Father's will, we celebrate in Holy Week and at Easter we see him glorified for his sacrificing his life by being raised from the dead and sharing his divine life, the new life of grace, with us.

Good Shepherd Sunday is also World Day of Prayer for Vocations, in particular to the priesthood and religious life, so that Jesus' work as shepherd of his people will continue to be carried out in our time. The word vocation means call and we speak of many roles that people have in life and society as a vocation. It is a vocation or call from God to a person to be a husband or wife, father or mother, doctor or nurse, teacher or support worker, carer or carpenter and many other roles, which we often fail to appreciate or may even take for granted. On this Sunday, however, the Church calls us to focus on the vocation of carrying on Christ's work as the Shepherd of God's people and to pray for people to embrace that special vocation.

There are moments for all of us when we can recognise or hear the call or voice of God speaking to us. It can be like "the still small voice of calm" speaking to us in our mind and heart, amidst the turmoil of the world and our own life. It may be an inkling, urge or prompt that may lead me to consider that the Lord is calling me to a particular way of life involving relationships, responsibilities or work and to fulfil my destiny in this world – that particular vocation once I have accepted it and it has been confirmed by the Church is God's call for me in this life and should lead me to my destiny in his kingdom. Please pray for Vocations to the priesthood and religious life so that people may hear and listen to God's call and generously respond to it in the service of his people. It is a privilege to be recognised and called by God to serve him by ministering to his people. Today we pray at Mass for Vocations to the Priesthood and religious life – may it always be a part of our prayers, and especially to pray for vocations in our own family and parish.

May we listen to the voice of the Good Shepherd and respond to his call. Fr John
