Dear Friends & Parishioners,

Jesus said, "In a short time the world will no longer see me; but you will see me, because I live, and you will live" (John 14:15-21). Jesus prepared his disciples for his leaving them at his death and his Ascension to the right hand of the Father in heaven. Resurrection, and Ascension of Jesus into heaven which we celebrate on Thursday, are two great Christian feasts that give us hope of life after death and the assurance that our Lord has not abandoned us but is with us always. Forty days after his resurrection Jesus met with his disciples and in their sight was taken up into glory, there to intercede for us at the right hand of his Father.

He promised his disciples and us a that he would send "The Advocate, who will be with you forever, the Spirit of Truth", who will lead us into all Truth – the Truth that will set us free and enable us to live in right relationship with God and with his people. The reality of that truth is presented to us by our Lord in the blessings or Beatitudes (Matt Ch.5) he confers on people when they or we go through all sorts of challenging, difficult or sad circumstances in life.

At the Last Supper Jesus gave his disciples a New Commandment, "Love one another as I have loved you". Before his Ascension he says to them, "Anyone who receives my Commandments and keeps them will be one who loves me, and anyone who loves me will be loved by my Father". Relationships are central to our life not only with people but also with God, and living in right relationship with God and people are key to fulfilling our destiny in life and in the world.

Acts Ch.8 shows us what happened when the Spirit, Jesus sent from the Father at Pentecost, came down on the Samaritans when they were prayed over and the apostles laid hands on them. Confirmation is an essential for all of us Christians, for through that Sacrament we receive the Spirit in a special way and with the laying on of hands and anointing with Holy Chrism we are strengthened in relationship with God and for our mission in life and the world. The Holy Spirit who is with us always offers us the gifts and graces of: wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, holiness and reverence, and we only need to call on him to make use of His gifts in our various circumstances. From Ascension Thursday to Pentecost Sunday, we have nine days (a novena) to pray for the coming and a new outpouring of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. *May we be open to receive the Holy Spirit and respond to his promptings.
