THE MOST HOLY TRINITY A HOLY TRINITY SUNDAY 4th June 2023

Dear Friends & Parishioners,

"In the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit" we say as we bless ourselves with the Sign of the Cross and at the beginning and end of our prayers. It shows we are addressing and calling on God, the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, the Three Persons in the Holy Trinity. We offer our prayers God our Father, through his Son Jesus Christ, who is our intercessor and friend of sinners, and under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit. In that way we honour our heavenly Father and Creator, his Son Jesus Christ our Saviour, and the Holy Spirit the Sanctifier who lives and acts in the Church, the World and our own hearts. We also have the Christian greeting in the names of the three persons in the Holy Trinity from 2 Cor.13 that says, "The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all".

Often people think of the mystery of the Holy Trinity as mathematical problem as they try to understand how there can be three persons in the One God. We need to see the Holy Trinity as the perfect loving relationship within the nature of God, which is revealed creatively to God's people. In Genesis 1, at the beginning of creation the Father speaks the Word, which becomes flesh in the person of Jesus, his only Son, and the creative Spirit is there hovering over the primeval waters, so that the Three Persons in the Holy Trinity are all present and acting in creation.

Many hymns speak to us of the nature and the Holy Trinity. "Firmly I believe and truly, God is Three and God is One", or "Holy, Holy, Holy! Lord God almighty! God in Three Persons, blessed Trinity!" or "Eternal Father, strong to save" or "Holy God, we praise thy name ... and adoring bend the knee, while we own the mystery". We are Baptised and make the Sign of the Cross in the name of the Holy Trinity. We say, "Glory be the Father, and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit", as we give thanks to God and honour the power and presence of the Holy Trinity.

"The Holy Trinity is the ultimate goal towards which our earthly pilgrimage is directed. The Holy Spirit guides us to full knowledge of Christ's teachings and reminds us of what he taught. Jesus came into the world to make the Father known to us, to guide us to him and reconcile us with Him. Therefore, we seek to remember what goal, what glory we exist for, work for, struggle for, suffer for, and what immense reward we are called to" (Pope Francis).

May God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit, bless and protect you. Fr John
