## Dear Friends and Parishioners.

"My house will be called a house of prayer for all the peoples" (Isaiah 56:1-7). Often people who belong to a religion even a particular church within Christianity, consider themselves exclusive and the only ones with a good relationship with God. In Isaiah's the prophecy the Lord tells of his love for all especially the "foreigners who attach themselves to him, to serve him and to love his name and be his servants". He speaks of leading people on a pilgrimage to his holy place and making them joyful in his house of prayer, "for my house will be a house of prayer for all the peoples".

It is sad nowadays that many churches are locked outside of times of worship, due to thieving, vandalism or lack of respect for the sacred. Some years ago here in Essex, a retired teacher who had not been Baptised or Christened had an extra-ordinary feeling one morning that she must go into a church and pray. She drove about fifteen miles passing many churches and having tried the doors found each one locked. She then came to a Catholic church that was open and after spending some time there, the priest happened to come into the church, and she told him of her (faith) journey that morning and desire to pray in a church. That led to her conversion and Baptism and becoming a very committed member of the church. It is a blessing for people and localities when churches are open for people to come to the Lord in his holy place, for he is always there for those who desire to come to him, and a blessing for people in this area and our community that our church is open every day from early to late.

In the Gospel (Matthew 15:21-28) we hear of the non-Jewish woman who comes to Jesus with great faith. Jesus' first response to her is typical of what his own people might have thought or said at time, for they would have seen her as an outsider who did not belong to "The Chosen People". Jesus recognises the depth of her faith and grants her the deliverance from evil and healing she seeks for her tormented daughter.

We express our gratitude to Fr Clement who has supplied here and in other local parishes during the holidays. It has ensured that the Masses have been celebrated here on the weekdays as well as weekends. We are most grateful to him for his generous help and he will celebrate Mass here next Saturday evening (26<sup>th</sup>). He left us on Friday for Harlow, where he has been helping out in the parishes for some years.

I hope everyone has had a safe and happy holiday and I enjoyed my time with my family. May the Lord draw us himself in his Holy House, the Church. Fr John
