FEAST OF THE EPIPHANY (B)

7th January 2024

We are coming to the end of Christmastide and the feast of the Epiphany not only celebrates the birth of Christ but also deepens our understanding of the purpose of his Incarnation—the 'epiphany' or revelation of God through his Son Jesus. Christ appears as a great light bursting through the darkness. All nations and races come to him and we accept him as our Saviour and King.
