CORPUS CHRISTI

Dear friends,

today we celebrate Corpus Christi, the feast of the Lord's Body and Blood. Last week's feast of the Blessed Trinity distinguishes Christianity from Judaism and Islam. Today's feast of the Holy Eucharist distinguishes Catholics from Protestantism. Catholics believe literally in Jesus' words: *this is my Body, this is my Blood.* We believe Jesus to be really present in the most holy sacrament reserved in the tabernacle. Every year the celebration of First Holy Communion highlights our determination to hand on this belief to our children. Since the Eucharist is not only the Blessed Sacrament of our Lord's Body but also his Blood, I strongly recommend reception from the chalice. Speaking personally it causes me sadness to see so many people pass the chalice by, thus failing the invitation "*take and drink*" given to us by Jesus himself.

Another lovely feast of the Lord occurs later during the week. Friday is the feast of the Sacred Heart when the Lord's humanity is emphasised. I still use often the prayer taught to me as a child: *Sacred Heart of Jesus I place my trust in you.* Jesus asks us to learn from him the example of humility and gentleness of heart. In a pushy and aggressive world it is a much needed lesson.
