THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

Today, we are reminded that this Feast, celebrated every year, now on the nearest Sunday to 15th August, is the most important of Marian feasts. The Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary commemorates the death of Mary and her bodily assumption into Heaven, - a foretaste of our own bodily resurrection at the end of time.

The Feast has been celebrated universally since the 6th century. In 1950, Pope Pius XII, after considering the views of Bishops all over the world and, in a rare example of Papal Infallibility, declared that it is a dogma of the Church: **“that the Immaculate Mother of God, the ever-Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory”** As a dogma, the Assumption is a required belief of all Catholics.

In this country, we have a special devotion to Mary and we ask her today to pray for us, as we do our best to please God by the way of life we choose.

This weekend, we welcome Fr John Taylor, a Mill Hill Missionary. Please pray for missionary work around the world, but particularly today for the work of the Mill Hill Missionaries.

Fr James expects to return from his holiday on Friday evening renewed and invigorated by his stay in Perth, Australia. I'm sure that we will all welcome his return to the fold.
