FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT 29th November 2015

Dear friends,

Advent is a precious time, all too easily eclipsed by the secular and commercial frenzy that precedes Christmas. It is a season of watchfulness and prayerful reflection helping us to prepare for the celebration of our saviour's birth. It is also the start of a new year in the Christian calendar. The twelve month period December 2015- November 2016 has been designated by Pope Francis as a ***Year of Mercy*** when the Church will engage in a heightened mission to those who, for one reason or another, believe themselves to be estranged or on the margins as Catholic Christians. As you leave Mass today you will be handed a complimentary pamphlet about the Year of Mercy. Please take it and use it in your personal devotions both in Advent and in the year ahead. One of the best ways of encountering God's mercy is through the Sacrament of Reconciliation which is especially emphasised in Advent and Lent - our own Advent Penance Service will be on Tuesday 15th December at 8pm.

Jesus says that those who show mercy to others will have mercy shown to them. In these troubled times the world is crying out for mercy to dispel the forces of hatred. Our own humble contribution to the spread of mercy lies in avoiding rash judgments of others and an endeavour to interpret their actions in the best possible way. However you intend to observe these days before Christmas, do not waste this opportunity to grow closer to our Lord who is never outdone in generosity and love.

PETITION NOT TO STOP HELP FOR MOTHERS IN CRISIS

PREGNANCIES: Abortion providers led by British Pregnancy Advisory Services are losing business because of the efforts of pro-life pavement counsellors who stand near clinics and offer women free help, **without coercion**, to avoid abortion. This is currently lawful provided there is no obstruction or harassment. Private clinics want to make it illegal (they receive £600 or more per abortion) by creating "buffer zones" around their premises. **Please sign** the petition to the Home Secretary on the notice board in the church porch.
