**THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK**

We may think we live in troubled times, but compared with others with whom we share this planet, our troubles are slight and comparatively insignificant. For example, we can think about the plight of migrants and those suffering from drought, famine or flood; then there are those suffering from religious persecution or the horror of terrorism. Closer to home, however, many of our woes are the result of relatively minor upsets to our expectation of enjoying a good standard of living. Many countries around the world would cheerfully swap their way of life with us.

Our 1st Reading at Mass today reminds us of the tremendous courage of the early followers of Christ. They were a very small group, but proclaimed their faith loudly, openly and fearlessly, being inspired by the evidence of the resurrection which they had witnessed, such as that recounted in today's Gospel. Our 2nd Reading from the Apocalypse emphasises the glory of life we might enjoy in heaven, and provided great comfort and encouragement to those early followers who were being hounded and persecuted by the Jewish authorities.

Surely, all this leads us to ask ourselves how strong is our faith today? What priority do we give to demonstrating our love of God? Do we have a good, strong daily relationship with him? Do we honour and worship him as he deserves? Or do we get distracted and 'worship' other gods, such as wealth, comfort, personal status etc? It's good to remind ourselves of God's importance and relevance in our lives as we try to grow in faith.

**STEWARDS OF THE GOSPEL**

As already announced, our Diocese has launched a major review of its resources and future needs, in the light of reducing numbers of clergy and mass-attending laity. The project is expected to provide a **Diocesan Plan covering the next 10 years**. Each parish is being asked to **appoint a lay-volunteer** to collect information about his or her parish, which will enable the collation of data within our deanery and, subsequently, across the whole diocese. Many parishes have now appointed a **Steward of the Gospel**, which is intended to be a relatively short-term appointment, but we have not yet had a volunteer come forward from our parish. Whilst **the preferred option is still to appoint one person**, we recognise that it **may be necessary to appoint a small team (2 or 3) to carry out this important task**. We are looking for volunteers with some **'organisational' background**, who can offer their skills on this project. It is **not expected that the time-commitment will be particularly heavy**. If you think you may be able to help with this challenging task, **please speak fairly urgently to Deacon Duncan or Fr James**, who will be pleased to explain further.

The Brentwood Catholic Youth Service (BCYS) trip includes the full WYD programme plus visits to the salt mines at Wieliska, a day in the mountains at Zakopane, and time visiting Auschwitz-Birkenau, as a sombre reminder of recent history. There are 90 young adults travelling and we have just 7 places remaining. The cost of £890 includes all travel, hotel accommodation and virtually all meals, as well as all excursions, and will be reduced to £640 by bursary funding if needed.
