#### Fourth Sunday of Easter

17th April 2016

Dear friends,

today is Good Shepherd Sunday when the Church worldwide offers up prayers for vocations to the priesthood. I use it as an opportunity to thank God for my own vocation given as a teenager sixty years ago. I have never regretted the commitment I made then since it resulted in a life of fulfilment and great happiness. Five other young men in my home parish of St Mary's Hornchurch went on to become priests as well. It is a sobering thought that Epping parish, founded in 1932, has never produced a single priest. All the more reason then that we should pray with ever greater urgency for vocations. Priesthood entails service and sacrifice and the aggressively secular mind set of our age is not conducive to fostering vocations. I would be happy to speak with any young, or not so young man, who may be thinking of answering our Lord's call: *follow me*.

The Easter season was marked by several bereavements in the parish. We offer prayerful condolences to the families of Mrs Pauline Johns, Mrs Angela Beard and Mrs Betty Bere, a parishioner of long standing. We pray that perpetual light may shine upon them and that those who mourn them may experience the solace of the Holy Spirit.

Deacon Duncan's appeal regarding parish finances met with a very positive response. Thank you to him and those who showed such interest.

### **STEWARDS OF THE GOSPEL**

As already announced, our Diocese has launched a major review of its resources and future needs, in the light of reducing numbers of clergy and mass-attending laity. The project is expected to provide a **Diocesan Plan covering the next 10 years**. Each parish is being asked to **appoint a lay-volunteer** to collect information about his or her parish, which will enable the collation of data within our deanery and, subsequently, across the whole diocese. Many parishes have now appointed a **Steward of the Gospel**, which is intended to be a relatively short-term appointment, but we have not yet had a volunteer come forward from our parish. Whilst **the preferred option is still to appoint one person**, we recognise that it **may be necessary to appoint a small team (2 or 3) to carry out this important task**. We are looking for volunteers with some **'organisational' background**, who can offer their skills on this project. It is **not expected that the time-commitment will be particularly heavy**. If you think you may be able to help with this challenging task, **please speak fairly urgently to Deacon Duncan or Fr James**, who will be pleased to explain further.

**WORLD YOUTH DAY (WYD) with Pope Francis, Krakow, 22<sup>nd</sup> July – 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2016.** If you are in school year 12 through to your early twenties, and want a "once-in-a-lifetime" opportunity then join Pope Francis and 3 million young people from across the world in Krakow this summer. The Brentwood Catholic Youth Service (BCYS) trip includes the full WYD programme plus visits to the salt mines at Wieliscka, a day in the mountains at Zakopane, and time visiting Auschwitz-Birkenau, as a sombre reminder of recent history. There are 90 young adults travelling and we have just 7 places remaining. The cost of £890 includes all travel, hotel accommodation and virtually all meals, as well as all excursions, and will be reduced to £640 by bursary funding if needed.
