Dear friends,

“I give you a new commandment: love one another.” These words of Jesus are at the heart of today’s gospel reading. They are also at the heart of Christian living and lie at the heart of Pope Francis’ most recent Exhortation entitled The Joy of Love. Whilst preserving traditional Church teaching on marriage and family life, this document dwells less on rules and regulations and places far greater emphasis on love and mercy when it comes to dealing with the complexities of modern domestic issues. The role of conscience is given due recognition as individuals and couples strive to live out the values of the gospel. The Pope is also making an appeal for mercy and pastoral discernment for those in situations that don’t live up to the ideals of Church teaching.

Catholic family life is enriched and nourished by weekly worship as part of the local family of faith which we call the parish. We come to Mass primarily to worship God and in so doing we draw strength from one another. We can sometimes feel lonely, both in the work place or the street in which we live, where most people have little or no faith. To feel part of a group, sharing our beliefs and values, which meets weekly to give expression to them, enables us to realise that we are not alone but can receive positive support when we need it.

WORLD YOUTH DAY (WYD) with Pope Francis, Krakow, 22nd July – 2nd August 2016. If you are in school year 12 through to your early twenties, and want a "once-in-a-lifetime" opportunity then join Pope Francis and 3 million young people from across the world in Krakow this summer. The Brentwood Catholic Youth Service (BCYS) trip includes the full WYD programme plus visits to the salt mines at Wieliczka, a day in the mountains at Zakopane, and time visiting Auschwitz-Birkenau, as a sombre reminder of recent history. There are 90 young adults travelling and we have just 7 places remaining. The cost of £890 includes all travel, hotel accommodation and virtually all meals, as well as all excursions, and will be reduced to £640 by bursary funding if needed.
