the opening prayer of today's Mass is a petition that we may always revere and love God's holy name. More than ever there is an urgency about its plea since profanation of the divine name is all too common. The names of God the Father and of Christ his Son are used as sacrilegious expletives on a daily basis in the media. In the gospel Jesus asks: *who do the people say that I am?* Then he goes on to ask: *who do you say that I am?* That is a very personal question and we must take great care to answer it with faith and love. Jesus is for us both Lord and Saviour and his name should not simply remain on our lips but be deeply embedded in our hearts and minds. We should use frequently the simple but lovely invocation known as the **Jesus Prayer: Lord Jesus have mercy on me.**

My recent cataract procedures have been very successful. I have now dispensed with glasses and am able to read even very small print with ease. Thank you for all your prayers and good wishes.

Do take the trouble to vote in next Thursday's referendum. The democratic process is a precious gift in our society and should not be taken for granted. I shall be voting to remain within the E.U.
