Our prayers go out for John Hawes, Fr James' brother, to his close priest-friends Canon John McGrath and Fr Michael Butler, and his fellow-priests in Australia, Mgr Michael Keating and Mgr Peter Kenny. Also, we grieve with his past parishioners of the last 50 years, all of whom will doubtless hold him in great affection.

We thank Bishop Alan for coming to celebrate all three Masses with us this weekend and express our love for him and offer our best wishes for his future leadership in our diocese.

As we all know, Fr James was to have retired to Leigh-on-Sea after Mass on 24th July 2016. Unfortunately, his plans have taken an unexpected course, but we were delighted to receive the news on Friday that Canon John McGrath, or Fr John as he prefers to be called, will be joining us as Parish Priest on the first week of September 2016.

Fr John, a native of County Clare, has been a close friend of Fr James for over 40 years. He comes to us from Billericay parish, where he has been Parish Priest for 12 years, following 10 years at Leigh-on-Sea. He brings with him a wealth of pastoral experience and a wry sense of humour (Fr James' words!). We will welcome him with enthusiasm, as he leads us at his first Masses in the parish on the weekend of 3rd/4th September.
