Some people are always on the move, but do they appreciate and savour their journey? Or are they focussed rather on getting their journey over so that they can get on with something else?

For good travellers, a journey is not just getting from Point A to Point B. It is a valuable life-experience and, just like a good meal, it is to be savoured and shared. The image of a journey has often been used as a reflection of human life and especially for life as lived in the light of the Christian faith.

Life can be seen as a journey without maps. God has not mapped out our lives in advance. He does not have our route carefully filed away in the memory of some giant computer. We have to work out our own route through life from the day of our First Holy Communion, using the precious gift of free will. We cannot delegate that responsibility to anyone. Every person's journey is unique. God is calling us into a very special journey and our life and his gift of faith provide our motivation. We have to trust in God's care and live our Christian lives as fully as we can. For all of us this will be a rich experience.

Today, we can ask ourselves "am I a good traveller with Christ?" Do I start and finish each day with a prayerful conversation with God? Do I tell him my plans, my successes and my shortcomings? We never need to travel alone!
