THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT YEAR A 19th March 2017

Dear Friends,

Jesus said, "Anyone who drinks the water that I shall give will never be thirsty again: the water that I shall give will turn into a spring inside him welling up to eternal life", (Jn.4:5-42). Jesus meeting the Samaritan woman at Jacob's well teaches us about the "water of life", which he offers to all who believe in him. Fr Sieger Koder's picture of Jesus with the woman at the well shows her looking down into the well, and seeing a reflection of the face of Christ, standing behind her, as well as her own face in the water. It tells us that if we look deep enough, we can see the face of Christ in other people and in ourselves too.

It is terrible to treat anyone in an inhumane way, yet there is the face and presence of Christ and something of the divine nature of God in every person. If we really understood this, we would have great reverence for our own and other people's bodies, as temples and dwelling places of the Spirit of God. In Baptism and blessing with Holy Water, priests and people demonstrate reverence for a person and the link between the human life and life of God, which we enter into through the waters of Baptism, and by which eventually brings us to share fully in the glory of heaven.

The grace of God and fountain of life is given to Christians by water and the Holy Spirit in Baptism. We are washed clean of sin and given the life of grace through the holy and life-giving water. The Spirit of God living in our heart gives us a share in the life and divine nature of God. He makes us holy and sacred, and sustains and renews our relationship with God in the Christian community. The woman at the well with Jesus found that he opened her heart to the truth, new life and relationship with God. Christ gave her the dignity, which was denied to her by others, and a share in the dignity we have as children of God. In sprinkling and blessing ourselves with holy water we are renewed in grace by Christ, the spring of living water in our heart. It is only by his grace that we are able to grow in the love of God and other people, and to love ourselves and others as God wills.

Try to draw close to God during Lent by coming to Mass on a weekday as well as on Sundays, or by taking part in the Stations of the Cross or other Lent devotions.

May God bless us in our journey of faith in this holy season of Lent Fr John.
