### **THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER**

**30<sup>th</sup> April 2017**

**My dear People,**

Jesus came up and walked by the side of the disciples but something prevented them from recognising him. He asked, "What are you discussing as you walk along?" (Luke 24:13-35). Luke's account of the Easter Sunday events shows the disciples mourning as they walk to Emmaus, and Jesus accompanying them on their journey. Like a good counsellor, he asked them to say what had happened to him and them over the last few days. Their expectation that he would found the kingdom of Israel had been shattered by his crucifixion and death. They were confused by the women telling them, "They had seen a vision of angels who declared that he was alive". Jesus let them express their pain as he listened, to them and asked them questions. He helped them understand God's plan by explaining the scriptures to them, and after recognising him in the "Breaking of the Bread" they said, "did not our hearts burn within us as he talked to us on the road".

This Gospel gives a model that can help us, our family and friends at certain times or occasions. We need friends to listen to us and our problems, and walk with us at painful times on life's journey, and help us to understand God's will and purpose in sad situations. The "Footsteps" meditation speaks of the Lord accompanying us on our journey through life as a friend, whom we may not recognise, for he is always with us never leaves us even in the most difficult times. The Word of God, which a person may share with us at troublesome times, can be like a beam of sunlight that pierces the clouds or mists of sadness, when we feel downcast or oppressed. When we share that Word of God with others, or they share his Word with us, it can be like Christ being present and offering his Word to interpret, guide or comfort us. That is why it is important for us to listen to, to read and to share the Word of God.

Next Sunday, we think of Christ the Good Shepherd, leading his people and calling them to follow him. We pray for vocations to the priesthood and religious life, so that people may hear the Lord calling them to serve God and others, by sharing in his ministry and work as Good Shepherd. We pray for vocations, so that the Lord's Word may be proclaimed and the Eucharist celebrated to give us the Bread of Life. **May Jesus, the Risen Lord, accompany us and give us joy & consolation.
