SECOND SUNDAY IN ADVENT Year C

9th December 2018

Dear Friends,

"John the Baptist went through the whole of the Jordan district proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins" (Luke 3:1-6). John came to prepare a way for the Lord by calling people to make a straight path for God to come into their lives by repenting of their sins. Many people do not want to recognise sin as disobedience to God and failing to love. Temptations lead us into sin by centring on self and promising us happiness. Sin brings us into an unhappy and broken state of mind and leaves us feeling let down or in guilt. In choosing sin by what we do or fail to do, we turn away from God and neighbour, and centre unhappily on ourselves.

The reading from Baruch 5:1-9, fills us with joy and hope as God promises to restore the dignity of his people when they respond to him with love. God takes away the sorrow and distress and gives people "Peace through integrity and honour through devotedness". By turning to God in a conversion of mind and heart, people find joy, and are in splendour, through living in right relationship with God and one another.

"What marvels the Lord worked for us! Indeed we were glad" is our response to Psalm 125. We praise and thank God for delivering us from evil and bringing us back to himself with joyful hearts. This Psalm emphasises what God has done for us, which makes us glad, for he frees us from the bondage and oppression of sin.

St Paul remembers the Philippians (1:3-11) with joy as they have taken the Gospel to heart and spread the Good News of God's saving love. He prays that they, and we, will grow more and more in love, and knowledge of God's will. By living pure and blameless lives, with the help of God's grace so that we come to perfect goodness and be clothed in glory. In that context it is essential in the midst of preparations for Christmas that we do not lose sight of Jesus, "The True Light", who is coming into our world and whose birth we celebrate at Christmas. A most important part of preparing for Christmas is to be reconciled to God and his people through the grace of forgiveness and reconciliation given to us in the Sacrament of Penance.

We express our gratitude to Bishop Thomas for coming to our Parish on Friday to celebrate the 25th Anniversary of the Dedication of our church, which he celebrated as Bishop of our Diocese in 1993. Our thanks to everyone who helped prepare for the religious and social aspects of this important celebration of faith in our parish. *May God bless us in Advent, as we prepare for Christ's coming to us, Fr John*
