### **THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT (Year A) 11<sup>th</sup> December 2016**

*Dear Friends,*

The joyful opening sentence of Mass this Sunday is:  
**‘Rejoice in the Lord always and again I say rejoice’.**

What a marvellous thought to take with us as we go about our daily lives!

On the first two Sundays of Advent, our liturgy has directed towards the promised second coming of Christ and its consequences for us and for the whole of humanity. We have been asked urgently to reflect on how ready we are to meet God, our loving maker, and what account we would give to him for the way in which we have shown our love for him and our neighbour in the hustle and bustle of ‘normal’ life. Have we proved ourselves worthy to join God in heaven for eternity, or do we fall short and have much to do to make God content with how we lead our lives?

On this third Sunday in Advent, we are encouraged to rejoice in the coming anniversary of the birth of Jesus Christ, who was to give his life to save us from the powers of evil. Does our way of life make us fit to benefit from his act of unselfish love? What could we do to show greater love for God and for our neighbour, having regard particularly to our involvement in the headlong rush which has come to characterise the build up to Christmas.

On Tuesday at 8pm we have our Penitential Service, at which we have the opportunity to reflect on our love for God and our neighbour and upon what we could do to love both God and our neighbour with more commitment. As always, when we ‘make a good confession’, it will improve our outlook on life and we will be truly able to **Rejoice in the Lord!**

My God bless us all as we improve our efforts to love him more during the last two weeks of Advent, over Christmastide and throughout the New Year.
