OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST, UNIVERSAL KING C 20 Nov 2016

Dear Friends,

Above Jesus on his cross was written, "This is the King of the Jews" (Luke 23:35-43). We are more familiar with the John 19:19 text that says, "Jesus of Nazareth, King of the Jews", which is expressed in the letters "INRI" on our crucifix. Today, we celebrate Christ the King, and honour him as our Lord and Saviour. He was crowned with thorns and raised up on a cross, but after his resurrection from the dead was taken up, and crowned in glory, as King of heaven and earth. Many aspects of Christ as King are stated in the hymns: "Hail Redeemer King Divine" or "Crown Him with many Crowns, the Lamb upon his throne" or "Christ is our King, let the whole world rejoice" and "The King of Love my shepherd is". In Christian art, Christ is shown as the King who reigns over peoples and nations, with the law of truth and love.

Christ as King draws all people to himself through his sufferings, death and resurrection (John 12:32). He came as a Servant King, "not to be served but to serve and to offer up his life as a ransom for many" (Matt 20:28). He shows us how to love, as we sing, "This is our God, the Servant King, he calls us now to follow him", we commit ourselves to share his love with others by caring for them. Through Christ, God's love is given to us and only through him can people be saved from sin and eternal death.

"The people of God share in Christ's Kingship, and the Sign of the Cross makes kings of all re-born in Christ with the anointing of the Holy Spirit, who consecrates us as priests and members of a royal race" (CCC 786). The Preface of Christ the King expresses this, and our response should be to give more room to Christ in our life and enthrone in our heart as our King, Lord and Saviour. On this Youth Sunday, we sing: "King most holy, King of truth, guide the lowly, guide the youth". Young people are faced with many difficult options, attractions and distractions and it can be difficult to focus on Christ, "The Truth", and to follow him by choosing what is right. We witness to Christ and the Gospel by being faithful to him and his call to love one another as he has loved us.

May Christ the King, rule our minds, our hearts and our wills. Fr John

APPLYING FOR A PLACE IN A CATHOLIC SCHOOL FOR SEPTEMBER 2017 - DIOCESAN GUIDANCE TO PARENTS/CARERS: Parents and carers who are **practising Catholics** and wish to apply for a place for their child in a Catholic school for September 2017 should hand in their form to the Priest's House, where it will be attended to by Fr John & Deacon Duncan. Some may be contacted to discuss the reference for their child. Families where parents and children are not practising their faith and do not attend Sunday Mass consistently, should make their application directly to the school but not request a priest's reference unless there are extraordinary circumstance in their situation. It is essential that integrity and truth are fully respected in in this process.
