FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER YEAR C - WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS 11th May 2025

On this 'Good Shepherd Sunday', the **Gospel** verses are taken from the tenth chapter of St John (10: 27–30). Here Jesus speaks of himself as the Good Shepherd, who brings life, love and protection to those within his flock.

In the **First Reading** (Acts 13: 14, 43–52) we follow Paul and Barnabas to Antioch, where their message is rejected by the Jewish leaders. Undeterred, they turn their preaching to those termed pagans. To the joy of the disciples, these people readily hear and receive the message of eternal life offered by the Lord, fulfilling the commission given by Jesus himself.

The **Second Reading** (Apocalypse 7: 9, 14b–17) recounts John's vision of heaven. Amid countless souls robed in the whitest of garments, we see Jesus as the Lamb, standing at the throne of God. We hear of the gifts of protection from hunger, thirst and sorrow which come to those who stand before God's throne.

This week, perhaps we can pray especially for those who, for whatever reason, may feel lost and without the protection of the shepherd they once knew. We also remember those who are searching for a flock in which to make their home. We continue to pray for peace across the world, and especially for the people of Ukraine and the middle East.
